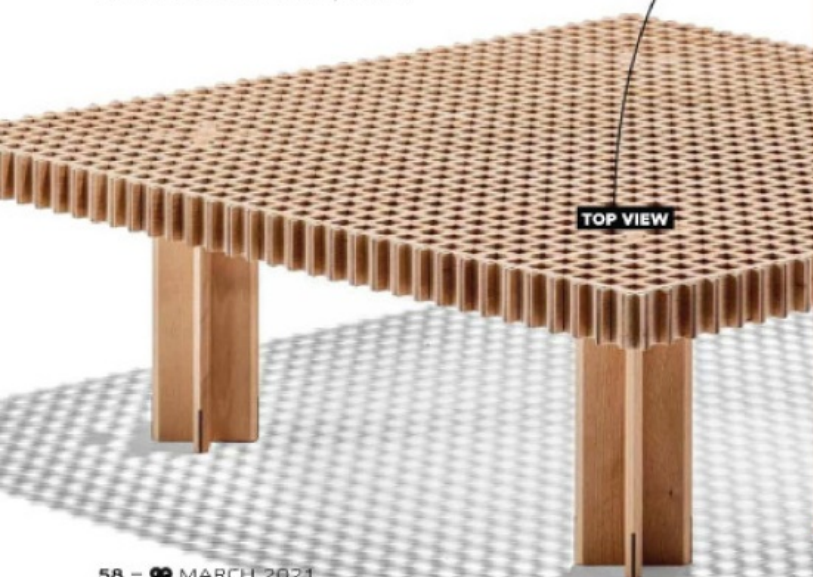




GO CRAZY
