



CHESTER SOFA BY ROBERTO LAZZERONI

With its historic capitonné on the backrest and its timeless elegance that celebrates the classic model used in English clubs and country houses during the Edwardian period, the Chester sofa was launched by Renzo Frau in 1912. Recently, Roberto Lazzeroni (born in 1950) gave it a new, contemporary look, adding two curved models to the Poltrona Frau collection, which can be used in tandem or on their own. This system of modular and curved sofas – with different elements: chaise longue and armchair, both without armrests; pouf, and two corner sofas – reinvents the iconic model and offers endless possibilities.
